Syllabus for Prep – 2012

*Quraan: Arabic alphabet – things to be emphasized:

- Identification
- Correct pronunciation of each letter. First term = 9 weeks (4 letters per week). By the 7th week all letters to be read correctly. After each week revision should be done before going to new letters. A test should then be given to the students, this will show which child needs more attention.
- Once the student has achieved this, he / she now advances to the Yassarnal Quraan.
- Identification of different forms of letters example; the form of the Alif when it is at the beginning, in the middle and at the end of a word.

Second part of the year:

- Arabic vowels to be taught: i.e. fattha (- /); dhamma (^ /) and kasra (/ -)
- Giving us the “u” sound = fattha (- /)
- Giving us the “oo” sound = dhamma (^ /)
- Giving us the “I” sound = kasra (/ -)

*Surah Memorisation:

- The method of teaching is “group teaching” where each verse is repeated five times or more.
- Surah’s to memorise for the year:
 1. Surah Faatihah
 2. Surah An-Naaz
 3. Surah Al-Kawthar
 4. Surah Al-Ikhlās
- By the end of the year each student must have memorised these surahs, in order to proceed to the next level.
- Two surah’s for the first six months and the next two the following six months.
